Precautions

- 1. This product does not come equipped with a probe. Please select a probe beforehand that fits the soldering iron that you use. Using an incorrect probe will hinder a correct measurement and dramatically shorten its life.
- 2. Please be careful as the LCD can deteriorate from direct sunlight or radiation. Furthermore, please avoid strong impact.
- 3. Do not disassemble this device for any reason. In the event that damage or trouble was caused by disassembling or altering the device, using it for any other reason than temperature measurement, or another reason beyond our control, repairs may not be conducted free of charge despite whether it is still within the warranty period.

Please abide by the following warnings in order to ensure your safety, prevent product damage, and ensure correct measurements.

Warnings In order to safely use this product, please:

- Do not use this product for any purpose other than measuring temperature.
- Immediately cease using this device if you feel any abnormality, and contact a retail shop or Anritsu Meter.
- Do not disassemble or alter this product.
- The probe becomes hot when measuring.

Do not directly touch the probe as it may result in burn or injury.

Cautions

Batteries

- Please use the specified batteries with this device.
- Insert + and polarity correctly.
- Remove the batteries when they die or when you are not going to use the device for a long time.
- Do not mix new and old batteries or battery types when using.

- Battery life varies greatly based on environmental temperature.
- Throwing batteries into fire, short-circuiting them, disassembling them, or heating them is strictly prohibited.

Functions and Handling

1. Affix the probe unit (sold separately) to the device's probe mount.

Make sure to pinch around the probe unit with your fingers when affixing and removing it. The probe unit is attached by a magnet, so it can be easily removed.

* Warning

The probe may become misaligned or detached upon strong impact, so please take into consideration an environment where the device will not be dropped or endure impact.

Pushing or pinching the metal portion of the probe unit's central part with force may damage the unit.



2. Turn on the power using the **POWER** key. Normally, the surrounding room temperature will be displayed.



Display at app. -300 to 400°C.

* The display may show a negative figure when the probe temperature is near 0° C.

- 3. Affix a proper amount of solder to the soldering iron that you are measuring and then lightly touch the tip to the probe.
- * Warning

Touching or rubbing the probe with the tip too strongly will dramatically reduce the probe's life and durability. Simply place the tip on the probe and it will respond adequately.

Also, please avoid measuring at high temperatures for long periods of time.

The probe becomes hot when measuring, so do not touch it directly with your hand and keep flammable objects away.



4. Display when changing batteries

When "LOBAT" is shown on the top-right part of the display, please turn off the power and replace all the batteries with new ones.

Confirm the battery's polarity and replace them correctly.

Trouble and Maintenance

Confirm the following points in the event of malfunction. If symptoms do not improve, promptly cease use of the product and contact a retail shop or Anritsu Meter.

- Display malfunctions
- → The batteries may have died. Please replace them with new batteries. Also, please check that the batteries are inserted in the correct direction.
- \rightarrow Please confirm the power key.
- Variances in the displayed temperature
- \rightarrow The batteries may have died. Please replace them with new batteries.
- \rightarrow Confirm that the probe unit is correctly set on the probe mount.
- → The display becomes unstable after a sudden change in environmental temperature. Please accustom the device to the environment for approximately 10 to 30 minutes.
- \rightarrow A malfunctioning probe. Please replace the probe.
- Light display
- \rightarrow The batteries may have died. Please replace them with new batteries.
- → The display becomes unstable after a sudden change in environmental temperature. Please accustom the device to the environment for approximately 10 to 30 minutes.
- Regarding maintenance
 - Do not directly touch the polar zone of the probe mount (where the probe unit is affixed). Clean probe units when they become dirty with solder residue and flux.
 - When not using the device for long periods of time, please remove and store the batteries.
